D3.1 Trained and educated participants of discovery diving courses

We did 117 discovery dives. We did discovery diving twice in camp Bale, Kraljevica, Komiža on the island of Vis, and at the pools in Stubičke and Krapinske toplice and Jelkovec.

In addition to discovery diving, participants also had the opportunity to view the educational trail that we laid on the seabed and in the pools. One part of the discovery diving was done with children with special needs, which was the most demanding part of this project. All of them managed to dive successfully and enjoyed the new experience and the educational workshops in which they received more information and knowledge about the biological diversity of the sea.













































D3.2 Trained and educated participants of scuba diving courses

50 participants successfully completed the Open Water Diver course, 31 Deep Dive, 4 Marine Ecology, 13 Navigation, 24 Night Dive, 21 Nitrox, 18 Perfect Buoyancy, 8 Photo & Video, 9 React Right, 8 Science of Diving, 8 Stress and Rescue, 10 Wreck Diving and 20 Advance Open Water Diver.

A total of 224 out of 258 participants successfully completed the education and met all the necessary standards.
























D4.2 Displayed photo exhibition at the end of project (closing ceremony) and conducted workshops


